

Information regarding road traffic





In general:

- During the period indicated below, road traffic in the downtown area of Lugano will be subject to rerouting of traffic or closure of some of the main roads during the event.
- However, traffic connections and traffic flow will be maintained.
- · Some public transport lines will also need to be rerouted.
- Access to Lugano for commuter and transit traffic will be facilitated via the Lugano Nord exit.
- Residents and delivery vehicles may access all streets except those closed to (vehicle) traffic.
- Motorists are advised to follow the instructions given by traffic police and to adhere to the signs posted.
- Vehicles parked anywhere other than in authorised locations (marked parking spaces) or without the consent of the traffic police will be towed away to ensure safety.

Start and end:

From Sunday, 3 July 2022, after the Swiss Harley Days 2022 event on 1-3 July 2022, at around noon, the following planned road closures and rerouting of traffic will begin (or those already in place will be maintained). The situation will continue until 6:00 am (when normal traffic conditions will resume) on 6 July 2022.

Commuter and transit traffic:

The zones and neighbourhoods situated north of Corso Enrico Pestalozzi/Viale Carlo Cattaneo (which runs through the downtown area) and the eastern part of town (situated between Viale Cassarate and Viale Castagnola) can be reached by road via the following routes:

Exit Lugano Nord on the A2 motorway / Vedeggio-Cassarate tunnel / Massagno – Cornaredo – Pregassona.

Signs will be placed on the A2 in both directions and information billboards will be used to help direct traffic along the motorway network.

Streets and main roads will not be closed off entirely but traffic restrictions will apply:

Via G.F. Ciani e Viale Cassarate Prolonged closures (15/30 min.) are possible – Suggested: Via Alla Bozzoreda – Via Ceresio

Via Clemente Maraini Prolonged closures (15/30 min.) are possible – Suggested: A2 motorway section between Lugano Nord or Lugano Sud exits

Lugano SBB train stationMorning from 4 to evening on 5 July roadblocks are to be expected with resulting disruption of traffic in the area along Via Besso.

Corso Enrico Pestalozzi/Via Cantonale/Via Pioda Traffic will be congested at certain times of the day and these routes will be subject to rerouting of traffic or road closures.

Special indications:

- Some parking areas in the town, excluding car parks, will not be accessible: Lugano Centro Esposizioni, Cornaredo riverside, parking Palazzo dei Congressi and Park&Ride Noranco (50% accessible)
- Public parking spaces alongside some streets in the downtown area may be temporarily marked as no longer accessible.
- Motorists, particularly delivery vehicles, are advised to reach the 'yellow' zones :

4 July In the morning until 9:00 am; afternoon from 1.00-3.00 pm.

5 July from 10.00 am to 2.00 pm.

 Ambulance (144) and fire brigade (118) personnel as well as health and social care workers will be able to access the red zones in consultation with the police, so as to maintain public safety and health.

Public transport:

Public transport lines, particularly those run by the Lugano Public Transport Company (TPL) will need to be rerouted.



1. Cassarate – Villa Castagnola





	routing of traffic from Sunday, 3 Wednesday, 6 July 2022, at 6.00
Via Pico	Closed between Via Funicolare and Salita delle Ginestre.
Via Giulio Vicari	Closed between Via Generale Arcioni and Viale Castagnola.
Salita delle Ginestre	Can be reached from Via Vittorino Vella and coming from the direction of the Via Pico roundabout.

General information:

- Motorists wishing to enter or leave residential areas and the downtown area are advised to take the A2 Lugano Nord Via Massagno junction or the Vedeggio-Cassarate tunnel.
- Times are indicative and may be adjusted as the event unfolds.
- Public parking spaces will be unavailable on streets closed to traffic and at the Lugano Centro Esposizioni. Parking may limited on restricted (yellow) streets.


At any given time, there may be additional road closures and rerouting of traffic apart from those indicated here.



2. Cassarate Foce – Lido – Centro esposizioni








Road closures and rerouting of traffic from Sunday, 3 July 2022, at 12.00 to Wednesday, 6 July 2022, at 6:00 am

Via Pietro Capelli	First road section between Viale Castagnola and Via del Tiglio closed.
Via del Tiglio	Access for residents from Via ai Faggi (one-way street will be temporarily opened to two-way traffic) with exit possible on Via Capelli.
Via Campo Marzio	Closed in both directions.
Viale Castagnola	Closed in the direction of Lugano downtown area, rerouting of traffic onto Viale dei Faggi, open in the direction of Cassarate-Gandria. Temporary closures are possible coming from Viale Cassarate.
Via Foce	Access for residents, authorised persons and commercial establishments
Viale Cassarate	Transit only possible in the direction of Cassarate-Gandria. Temporary closures of at least 15 min possible.



3. Palazzo dei congressi – Nord





Road closures and rerouting of traffic from Sunday, 3 July 2022, at 12.00 to Wednesday, 6 July 2022, at 6.00 am

Viale Carlo Cattaneo	Closed in both directions. Home parcel delivery for the three streets Via Pasquale Lucchini, Via Luigi Lavizzari and Via Landriani will be possible by taking Corso Elvezia and then turning onto Luigi Canonica. Access to house numbers 19 to 27 will be possible from Viale Cassarate.		
Corso Enrico Pestalozzi	Closed between Via G.B. Pioda to Corso Elvezia. Home parcel delivery will be possible from the second road section of Corso Enrico Pestalozzi, towards via Pietro Bianchi and via Stauffacher. The one-way Piazza Indipendenza street will be temporarily opened up to two-way traffic.		
Viale Cassarate	Transit will only possible in the direction of Cassarate-Gandria. Temporary closures of at least 15 min. possible.

Road closures and rerouting of traffic from Sunday, 3 July 2022, at 12.00 to Wednesday, 6 July 2022, at 6.00 am


Riva Giocondo Albertolli, Riva Vincenzo Vela	Home parcel delivery unimpeded.
Via della Posta	Accessible and useable only for home parcel delivery and authorised persons (police), from Riva Giocondo Albertolli and exiting on Corso Enrico Pestalozzi.
Via Canova	Accessible for residents and authorised persons only, from via Riva Vincenzo Vela / Via degli Albrizzi.
Via Stauffacher, second road section	Access to garages will be from Enrico Corso Pestalozzi (one-way street will be temporarily opened up to two-way traffic).
Quartiere Maghetti	Accessible from Via della Posta, Via Canova. Maghetti car park accessible via Corso Pestalozzi.



5. Lugano LAC – Loreto – Paradiso







Geretta – Paradiso: follow the instructions given by traffic police on site and the signs posted.

Road closures and rerouting of traffic from Sunday, 3 July 2022, at 12.00 to Wednesday, 6 July 2022 at 6.00 am

Paradiso – Lugano	radiso – Lugano Northbound transit traffic will be diverted to Viale Giuseppe Cattori in the direction of the A2 motorway or the Lugano SBB train station.	
Riva G. Albertolli	Residents and authorised persons. On the evening of 4 July from 5.30 pm to 11.00 pm, there may be temporary closures near the LAC.	
Loreto	No restrictions. To enter or leave the area, motorists should take Via Antonio Riva - Via Ponte Tresa or head towards A2 Lugano Sud.	
Via C. Maraini	Traffic congestion and temporary closures can be expected near the Lugano SBB train station.	
Riva A. Caccia	Traffic unimpeded up to the LAC roundabout, then traffic will be diverted onto Via Antonio Adamini and Via Giuseppe Mazzini. Access for residents and authorised persons will be maintained. No restrictions for residents on Via G. Mazzini and Via A. Adamini.	
Via D. Fontana	Access to Viale Giuseppe Cattori will be closed. The exit will be on Via Silvio Calloni (general road closure lifted).
